

## YOUR CHECKLIST FOR FAMILY MOVING



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- Post Office: Give forwarding address.
- Charge Accounts, Credit Cards.
- Subscriptions: Notice requires several weeks.
- Friends and Relatives.
- Transfer bank funds, arrange check-cashing in new city.
- Notify new location for coverages: Life, Health, Fire, Auto
- Transfer of car title registration is necessary, also drivers license, city windshield stickers, motor club membership.
- Gas, light, water, telephone, perhaps fuel: get refund of a deposit made, arrange in new town for immediate services.
- Laundry, paper boy, milk man: change over of services.
- Ask for copies or transfer of children's school records.
- Ask Doctor and Denitst for referrals, transfer needed prescriptions, eyeglasses, X-rays (histories).
- Transfer memberships: get letter of introduction.
- Church, Clubs, & Civic Groups
- Ask about pet regulations for license, vaccinations, tags, etc.

### DON'T FORGET TO:

- Empty freezer; plan use of foods.
- Defrost freezer-refrigerator. Place charcoal to dispel odor.
- Have appliances serviced for moving.
- Remember arrangements for TV antenna.
- Clean rugs or clothing before moving: have them wrapped.
- With your moving counselor check: insurance coverage, packing/unpacking labor, arrival day, various shipping papers, method & time of expected payment.
- Plan for special care needs of infants.

### AND ON MOVING DAY:

- Carry currency, jewelry, & documents yourself, or use registered mail.
- Plan for transporting pets; they are poor traveling companions if they are unhappy.
- Carry travelers checks for quick, available funds.
- Let close friends or relatives know the route & schedule you will travel including overnight stops, use them as a message headquarters.
- Double check closets, drawers, shelves, to be sure they are empty.
- Leave all old keys needed by new tenants or owners with agent or Realtor.
